Thank you for completing and implementing the corrective action plan that resulted from the Administrative Review of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) in the Imagine School at Mountain View from January 18 through January 20, 2017.

The corrective action plan has been approved pending one item and the Administrative Review is now closed.

The one pending item is regarding the smart snack items in the vending machines. Nutrition fact labels were sent for the items that were currently being sold in the vending machines. The following items do not meet the smart snack nutrition standards and can no longer be sold during the school day:

- Chocolate Brownie (company unknown) – 1st ingredient is not a whole grain
- Chocolate Chip cookie (company unknown) - 1st ingredient is not a whole grain
- Iced Oatmeal Cookie (company unknown) - 1st ingredient is not a whole grain
- Pirates Booty – total fat is greater than 35% and first ingredient not a whole grain
- Lays Oven Baked Cheetos – sodium is greater than allowed 200 mg (350 mg)
- Lays Oven Baked Barbeque Potatoes Chips - sodium is greater than allowed 200 mg (220 mg)
- Lays Rold Gold Tiny Twisted Pretzels - sodium is greater than allowed 200 mg (900 mg)
- SMARTFOOD White Cheddar Cheese Popcorn - sodium is greater than allowed 200 mg (220 mg)
- All Propel Waters and any beverages that are not 100% juice, milk, or plain water. Per the Nevada State Wellness Policy elementary schools cannot sell any beverages other than: plain water, low fat, unflavored milk, non-fat unflavored or flavored milk, and 100% fruit/vegetable juice.

Please do not reorder any of the items listed above for sell in the vending machines during school hours. Alternatively the vending machines can be turned off during school hours, and those items sold 30 minutes after the end of the school day. Please inform NDA of the decision you choose.

Thank you again for your continued efforts to provide nutritious meals to the youth at Imagine School at Mountain View. Your review is now closed and the withhold payment status is removed.
